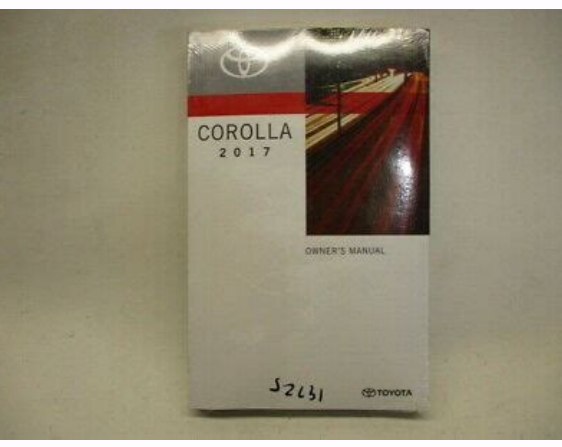
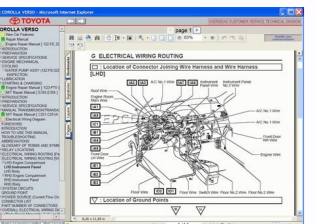
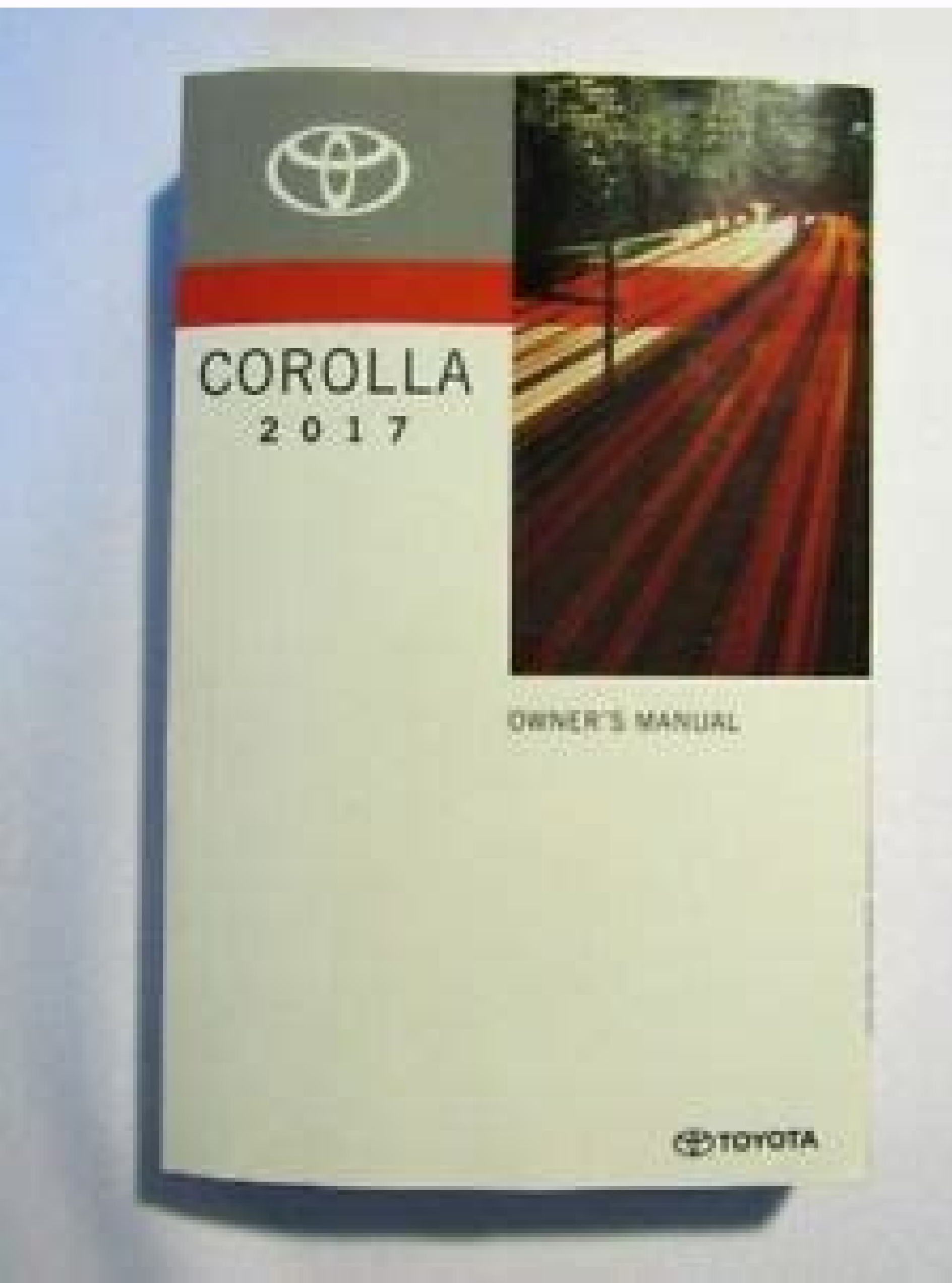

 - Remove the output gear spacer from the output shaft.
- REMOVE 2ND GEAR**
 - Using SST and a press, remove the 3rd driven gear with 2nd gear from the output shaft. SST 09950-00020
- REMOVE 2ND GEAR NEEDLE ROLLER BEARING**
 - Remove the 2nd gear needle roller bearing from the output shaft.
